

# Annex A: Behaviour Principles

In light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school, these are the new behaviour changes.

- Children will arrive and depart at different times
- Handwashing needs to be carried out at least 6 times per day
- Children must stay within their bubbles
- Everyone stays in their areas. There will be limited movement around the school building.
- Teach children - sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- Children must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- No sharing equipment including drinking bottles
- Different breaks or play times – Children to play in allocated areas with allocated equipment
- Children to use allocated toilets. Only two children per toilet and no waiting
- Teach children clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person when speaking
