The Clubs provided for this Summer Term are as follows:

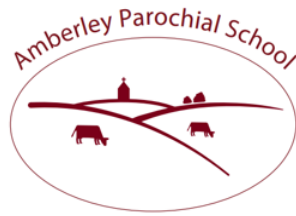

I would be grateful if you could discuss the Clubs offered with your child and return a Clubs List Form. Please return your completed forms to the School Office by **Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022**.

**All Clubs will start week commencing Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> June 2022, with the exception of Multi-Sports Club Y1/2/3, which will commence Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022.** Please see the chart above for start and finish times for the various Clubs.

If your child would like to take part in any of these voluntary activities, we would ask that the following points be taken into account:

1. The children are committed to attending the club on a weekly basis. If children are unable to attend they must inform the adult in charge beforehand. If a child regularly fails to attend the club their place could be given to another child and/or they may not be given the opportunity to participate in matches, events or competitions.
2. The children obey the rules of the club as outlined by the member of staff/parent volunteer in charge. If children are unable to behave, they will be asked to leave the club. The “three strikes and you are out” policy still applies.

3. If for any reason the club has to be cancelled, the school wherever possible will give advanced warning via the Amberley Newsletter. If the weather is poor and you are in doubt, please ring the School Office (01453 873349). If a club is cancelled at short notice parents are responsible for collecting their children at 3.15pm.
4. Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn for all activities.
5. Where races or matches are arranged, it is hoped that Club members will take part and represent the school.
6. Where a charge is levied for a Club, this will be collected directly by the Club organiser
7. Should you arrive late to collect your child, they will be placed within the Atlas Sport After School Provision and you will be charged £10

**Please ensure that you have discussed the above conditions with your child and that you both sign the form having accepted them.**
