In September 2013, new funding was made available to schools to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.

During 2019-2020 we wanted to achieve these things:

- Every child participates in 2 hours of PE
- 80% of children attend a sports club
- Achieve Silver School Games Award
- Embed Outdoor learning / DT across the school
- Raise the profile of PE within our school curriculum
- Ensure all pupils can access the residential trip in year 5/6
- PE equipment is well maintained
